It's been a busy season for us as we've moved, settled into our new home, and adjusted to ministry. But now, we finally feel at home and are excited to see what God has in store for us as we step into this new chapter.

Our neighbourhood is full of young families, which has been a blessing. Chanjoo has already connected with a few moms with young kids she met at the park. Another missionary family also moved just down the road—they have three young children, two of whom are close in age to ours.

We're still searching for a church. So far, we've visited four different churches but haven't felt confident about any of them. Please continue to pray for us as we continue to search for a church!



Ministry

This past month, I've had the opportunity to get involved in several ministries with our team. A few other missionaries and I helped a local Christian school run a week-long VBS. Through games and Bible lessons, we were able to have daily conversations with the students about the gospel.

I also had the privilege of preaching the gospel to 300 high school students during a morning chapel at another Korean Christian school. The following week, we held a Bible club at the same school. After the gospel was shared again, we broke into small groups for discussion. Some students were eager to learn more, while others joked around and seemed uninterested.

This past week, our team went out for street evangelism for the first time. We chose a location near the U.S. military base, where we could have

conversations in both English and Korean. It was so encouraging to see our team step out in faith and boldly share the gospel with strangers!

Meanwhile, Chanjoo and another missionary recently started a weekly women's Bible study with the single ladies on our team. They are currently studying the book of Proverbs together.





Upcoming Vietnam Missions Trip

Our team is currently preparing for a trip to Vietnam in June 2025 to help Word of Life Vietnam run an English Camp! This year, we're expecting 100–120 campers. This will be our second trip of this kind, and we would greatly appreciate your prayers as we prepare. Please also pray for the Vietnamese students—that their hearts would be open to the gospel as God's Word is preached.

We are working to raise \$14,000 USD to cover flights and accommodations for our 14 team members.
