## 3 Months In

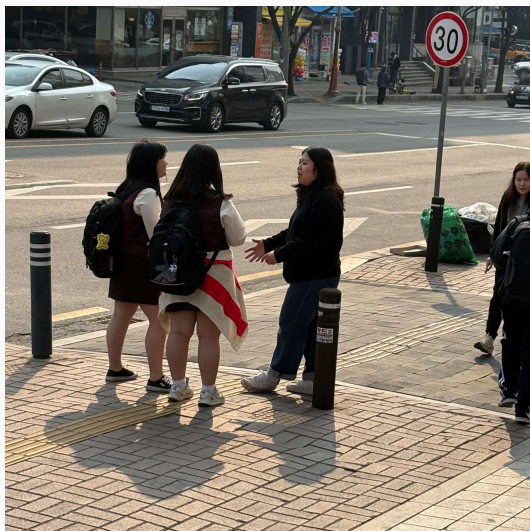
It's hard to believe our family has already been in Pyeongtaek for three months! We've been overly blessed and warmly welcomed by the Word of Life Korea team.

Each week, a few of us from the team head out to the streets around the time local middle and high school students are finishing school. We offer them peach tea and hand out gospel tracts we recently designed to help start conversations about the gospel. Many students have been kind and open, and I'm thankful for their patience as I share the gospel in my still-improving Korean. I've also been taking a weekly class focused specifically on practicing evangelism in Korean—it's been a big help, and I'm excited to see how God continues to work through our team.

Our team also regularly visits local Christian schools and churches to run short day camps and build relationships with students. Each week, we focus on a different topic, teach a lesson, and then lead small group discussions. This past week, I had the chance to teach on the topic of the Christian family. During

the discussion time, we had good conversations about what it means to be a child of God.

Please continue to pray for these growing relationships with the students—that God would open hearts and draw them to Himself.

## Upcoming Vietnam Missions Trip

Our team is currently preparing for a trip to Vietnam in June 2025 to help Word of Life Vietnam run an English Camp! This year, we're expecting 100–120 campers. This will be our second trip of this kind, and we would greatly appreciate your prayers as we prepare. Please also pray for the Vietnamese students—that their hearts would be open to the gospel as God's Word is preached.

We are working to raise \$16,000 USD to cover flights and accommodations for our 14 team members. We are currently 38% funded.

- Pray for our interactions with locals (especially students) as we do street evangelism. Pray for our team to be bold, and that God would bring seeking souls our way.
- Pray for wisdom as we continue to search for a church. We have found a potential church but still need to find out a few more things before we commit.
- Pray for unity within our team and for each of us to be spiritually healthy. Pray that I would have wisdom as I oversee the short-term staff.
- Pray for us as we prepare for summer camp in July and August. Pray for wisdom in planning and setting up leaders, preachers, and counsellors. Pray for the campers hearts to be readied to hear to gospel.
- Our Bible Club team goes out about 3-4 times a week to different schools and churches to teach the Bible and connect with students. Pray for the

salvation of those who do not yet believe and for the continued growth of those who are in Christ.

- Pray for our team as we prepare for our trip to Vietnam. Pray that God would prepare the hearts of the campers and that we would trust in God to provide all we need for the trip.
- Pray for my Korean (especially in evangelism) to continually improve.
- Pray for our family—for Chanjoo as she serves at home, for the salvation of our children, and for wisdom as I balance family and ministry.

There's a lot of construction happening in our neighbourhood right now, so just going for a walk can turn into quite an adventure if he spots an excavator!

Chanjoo has been leading a Bible study with the girls on our team and has started building friendships with a few moms in our town. Some of these connections have grown into family hangouts, and her hope is to eventually start a Bible study with a few of them. Please pray for continued open doors!
