## 2 Years of Language School Comes to an End

The time has finally come. After a year of raising ministry funds and two years of studying Korean, we are now stepping into full-time ministry. Yet, more than being financially or linguistically prepared, we know that spiritual preparation is what matters most. We must be ready in season and out of season to preach the Word. We are excited to see what the Lord has in store as we continue our mission to reach the Korean people with the gospel, especially young people. I'm grateful for the foundation I now have in Korean and look forward to ministering to Korean people in their own language. Thank you so much for your prayers throughout my time in language school!



**What exactly will I be doing?**

I know that some of you may not be entirely sure what I (Jason) will be doing in ministry. As many of you know, my main desire is to focus heavily on evangelism. In the past, Word of Life Korea had a program called SYME (Student Youth Ministries in English), where Korean students could live on our campus, learn English, and most importantly, hear the gospel. However, the Lord closed that door during COVID, leading us to shift our focus as a ministry. First and foremost, we are here in Korea to serve the Church. We do this by going to churches to run camps, Bible clubs, and evangelistic training for church leaders. We also hold camps on the mainland and Jeju Island in both summer and winter, in which I will be involved in. I also have the privilege and responsibility of shepherding our short-term missionaries and interns who come to serve after studying at Bible school. Along with them, I plan to begin doing street evangelism locally and in other major cities across Korea. Please pray for my personal ministry and for our ministry as a whole—that our lives and message would glorify God and that many would come to salvation by His grace.
